You can think of the power content label as a "nutrition label" for electricity. The power content label provides information about the energy resources used to generate electricity that is put into the power grid. Just as a nutrition label provides information about the food you eat, the power content label provides information about your electricity sources.

Public Utilities Code - PUC 398.1. (a) says:

(a) The Legislature finds and declares that there is a need for reliable, accurate, timely, and consistent information regarding fuel sources for electric generation offered for retail sale in California.

My questions are related to what is included and excluded on the AB 1110 power content label.

SolarShares which is net metered electricity usage and is not electric generation offered for retail sale in California is shown on the label.

Greenergy is available for 100% and 50% of electricity usage, yet the label only shows 100% Greenergy.

Where in the current and proposed regulations does it allow net metered electricity usage such as SolarShares to be included on the label?

Where in the current and proposed regulations does it allow retail sales such as 50% Greenergy to not be included on the label?

The current and proposed regulations do not provide reliable, accurate, timely, and consistent information for electric generation offered for retail sale in California without substantial changes in regulatory language.
