NOTICE OF SB 100 TECHNICAL WORKSHOP

The California Energy Commission (CEC), the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), and the California Air Resources Board (CARB) will conduct a joint workshop to discuss technologies and inputs for technical analysis to inform the joint agency report required by Senate Bill (SB) 100, the “100 Percent Clean Energy Act of 2018” (de León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018).

CEC Chair David Hochschild will conduct this workshop with CEC Commissioner J. Andrew McAllister and CPUC Commissioner Liane Randolph. A quorum of commissioners may be in attendance, but no votes will be taken.

Agenda

The workshop will begin with presentations from staff and stakeholders on renewable and zero-emission generation technologies, and existing studies related to decarbonization. Staff will also discuss planned Modeling and analysis for the SB 100 report.

This will be followed by public comment.

Background

SB 100 requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to complete and submit a joint agency report to the Legislature evaluating the 100 percent zero-carbon electricity policy. The SB 100 report will be informed by a public process and qualitative and quantitative analyses to address the requirements and intent of the statute.

The requirement is codified in Public Utilities Code section 454.53, and the full text is available at

Public Comment

Oral comments. Oral comments will be accepted at the end of the workshop. Public comments may be limited to three minutes or less per speaker and to one person per organization.
