We must have more local energy sources focusing on clean energy production and very low transmission distances.

We need to reform Transmission Access Charges (TAC) so that local renewables do not pay TAC charges of 2- 3 cents per kWh. Don't fall for the fake renewable natural gas solution

Studies suggest that building electrification, which reduces or eliminates the use of gas in buildings, is likely to be a lower-cost, lower-risk long-term strategy compared to renewable natural gas (RNG, defined as biomethane, hydrogen and synthetic natural gas, methane produced by combining hydrogen and carbon). Furthermore, electrification across all sectors, including in buildings, leads to significant improvements in outdoor air quality and public health.
