

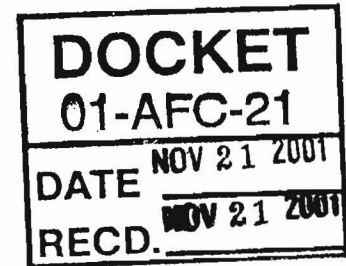

On October 18, 2001, Midway Power, LLC, the owner of the Tesla Power Project, submitted a Request for Temporary Confidential Treatment regarding sources of air quality emission reduction credits. This request was granted by the Executive Director in a letter dated November 6, 2001. On November 8, the CEC staff requested additional information with respect to the location of the proposed ERC sources (AQ Data Requests 7 and 8). I have attached this requested information and hereby request confidential treatment under 20 CCR 2505 (a)(4).
