On November 26, 2019, the California Energy Commission (CEC) Committee (Committee)¹ issued a "Notice of Committee Conference and Orders on Hearings",² which among other things directed Staff to submit a proposed schedule for this proceeding by December 4, 2019 and directed the Applicant to file a response to Staff's proposal by December 11, 2019. Staff and Applicant met these deadlines.³

On December 18, 2019, Staff provided this email, with an updated proposed schedule generally consistent with the schedule proposed by Applicant.⁴

The parties are invited to file comments on the proposed schedule by 5:00 p.m., January 14, 2020, after which time the Committee will submit a schedule to guide this proceeding.
