To exit the infinite loop caused by Title 20, Section 1409's reference to Section 1404, the procedure needs identification for a formal process for certification of the public domain software pursuant to Public Resources Code - PRC 25402.1. (a) as developed by the Energy Commission, pursuant to Public Resources Code - PRC 25402.1. (b) requirement that the Energy Commission establish a formal process for certification of compliance options.

There is a procedure for approval of non-public domain computer programs identified in Title 24 10-109. No procedure appears to exist for the approval of the public domain software pursuant to Public Resources Code - PRC 25402.1. (a).

These rules of general application for the procedure for approval of the public domain software pursuant to Public Resources Code - PRC 25402.1. (a), as cited in Title 24, 10-109 building standard, does not appear to have a express exemption to the requirements of Health and Safety Code - HSC 18930. (a).
