### **Agenda**

The workshop will begin with presentations from staff reviewing the approach for analysis for the SB 100 Joint Agency Report. Staff and consultants will present background on the model to be used for the quantitative SB 100 analysis, including inputs, assumptions, and planned scenarios. A stakeholder panel will discuss considerations for inputs and assumptions related to reliability, land use, equity and environmental impacts.

### **Background**

SB 100 establishes a policy of the state that eligible renewable energy resources and zero-carbon resources supply 100 percent of all retail sales to California end-use customers by December 31, 2045. SB 100 also requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to complete and submit a joint agency report to the Legislature evaluating the 100 percent renewable energy and zero-carbon electricity policy. The SB 100 report will be informed

by a public process and qualitative and quantitative analyses to address the requirements and intent of the statute. The requirement is codified in Public Utilities Code § 454.53, and the full text is available at [https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes\\_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53](https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53).
