Remote Attendance

WebEx is the CEC's online meeting service. When attending remotely, presentations will appear on your computer/laptop/mobile device screen and audio may be heard via the device or telephone. Please be aware that the WebEx meeting may be recorded. WebEx technical support is available at 1-866-229-3239.

Via Computer: Go to <https://energy.webex.com/ec>. If this event is listed, click "Join." If not, click the "Unlisted Events" on the left of your screen and enter **Event Number 925 242 779**. When prompted, enter your name and email address. No password is needed.

The "Join Conference" menu offers a choice of audio connections:

1. To call into the meeting, select "I will call in" and follow the on-screen directions.
2. International attendees, select "Global call-in number."
3. To have WebEx call you, enter your phone number and click "Call Me." This step will not work if your number has an extension.
