# Background

The CEC updates the California Building Energy Efficiency Standards on a three-year cycle. The CEC is considering the scope and analysis needed now for the 2022 Energy Code that goes into effect on January 1, 2023. Staff prepared this report to seek public input on CEC staff recommendations for the 2022 Energy Code related to the acceptance test technician certification provider program, acceptance testing, and nonresidential data registry requirements.

Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider Program (ATTCPs): The CEC approves professional organizations as ATTCPs to provide training, certification, and oversight of Acceptance Test Technicians (ATTs) who perform the acceptance tests required by the Energy Code. As of July 1, 2014, only a certified lighting control ATT can perform acceptance testing for lighting control installations. However, uncertified technicians can still perform acceptance testing for mechanical system installations.

**Nonresidential Data Registry:** A nonresidential data registry is a web service with a user interface and database that is maintained by a CEC approved registration provider for the registration of all nonresidential compliance documentation when required by the Energy Code. To date, the CEC has not approved a nonresidential data registry.
