NOTICE OF RECEIPT
PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION PROJECT CHANGE
LODI ENERGY CENTER (08-AFC-10C)

On March 11, 2020, the Northern California Power Agency (NCPA) filed a post-certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Lodi Energy Center (LEC). The combined-cycle, natural gas-fired, electricity generating, 296-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision in April 2010, and became operational in November 2012. The facility is located in the City of Lodi (City), San Joaquin County, California.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

This request includes the following changes:

- To amend the LEC project description to include an additional 9.4 acres of laydown area adjacent to the LEC site.
