on the effectiveness of programs related to the Clean Energy and Pollution Reduction Act of 2015 (also known as Senate Bill 350) in disadvantaged communities.

Public Comment

Oral comments. The DACAG will accept oral comments on each agenda item during the meeting, as well as general comments at the conclusion of the meeting. Comments may be limited to three minutes per speaker and one speaker per organization. Any comments will become part of the public record.

 7. Enter the CAPTCHA that is used to prevent spamming on the website. Then click on "agree and Submit your Comments."
