Good Morning:

We recently attended the workshop for the Zero Emission Transit Fleet Infrastructure Deployment program and have two follow-up questions:

- For Funding Category 1 (Up to \$10 million): – Will the CEC consider funding an applicant in the process of procuring electric buses (for an eventual fleet of 70 electric buses)? Must all 50+ buses required for eligibility in Funding Category 1 be electric or hydrogen fueled buses at the time of application, or can an applicant operating a fleet of 50+ buses (with a mix of electric, CNG, and LNG buses) and in the process of converting to 100% electric fleet also apply under Category 1.
- Can expenses be incurred prior to the execution of the grant agreement? If construction of infrastructure improvements begins prior to January 2021, can an applicant seek reimbursement for these expenses, or use these expenses as part of their match commitment?
