Hi Karim,

I am well, thanks for asking. I hope you and yours are doing well also.

The project civil engineer indicates that the soil stabilization will not require much water to achieve the optimum moisture content and that other water uses will be fairly low volumes, leaving dust control as the largest construction water use. While the overall construction duration is 16 months, major construction water demands will generally be for the first 9 months, tailing off significantly after installation of hardscape. Therefore, the estimated construction water use is approximately 51 acre-feet.

Hi Jerry,

How are you? I hope you are well.

I was looking for the approximate amount of water you expect to use during the construction phase of the project. I thought we asked this question during one of our data requests, but apparently we did not, nor was I able to find it in the SPPE application. Sometimes I estimate the amount based on the acreage of the site and assuming 1,000 gallons per day per acre for dust suppression, but this gives me about 90 ac.ft (using 16 months of construction as stated in the application). This assuming that most of the water would be used for dust suppression. However, in your case where you might excavate the whole site to a depth of up to 65 ft for soil stabilization, that will require a lot of water, don't you agree? Therefore, I did not want to venture a very large estimate and thought you might have a more accurate estimate for me that I can use.
