NOTICE OF REMOTE-ACCESS WORKSHOP

RE: Block Grant Incentive Project

Notice of Staff Workshop on Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Training Requirements for CALeVIP

California Energy Commission (CEC) staff will host a remote-access workshop to discuss workforce training and certification requirements for electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure deployment and solicit stakeholder feedback. The workshop will present California Electric Vehicle Incentive Project (CALeVIP), workforce training and development efforts, and licensing requirements, and explore the pros and cons of requiring additional training and certification for EV charging infrastructure installation. A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public can participate and observe the workshop consistent with the direction in these Executive Orders. Instructions for remote participation are below.

Agenda

Workforce development and training play a crucial role in supporting EV charger deployments across the state. This workshop will inform staff on the licensing requirements for current contractors, as well as the availability and efficacy of targeted training and certification programs specific to EV charger deployment.

Discussion topics will include:

1. CALeVIP background
2. Workforce training and development investments under the Clean Transportation Program
3. Training and certification, including the Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program (EVITP)
4. Charging Network Development
5. Public Comment Period

Background

CALeVIP is funded under the CEC's Clean Transportation Program. CALeVIP maintains an online interface that allows individuals who are interested in installing EV chargers to easily access resources, connect with companies that sell or install chargers, and apply for rebate funding via a simplified and streamlined application process. To date, CALeVIP has \$76.1 million in six active incentive projects. Two additional incentive projects will launch in 2020.

Through the Clean Transportation Program Investments, the CEC helps expand programs in workforce development and training and develop new programs to support workers in California's zero-emission vehicle and infrastructure sectors. These programs support the state's transition to clean transportation, provide pathways to sustained clean-transportation job opportunities, and help to achieve the state's greenhouse gas reduction goals.
