I am vehemently opposed to the Great Oaks South Backup Generating Facility Small Power Plant Exemption. My home is located just across the street from the proposed site. I have an unobstructed view of the site and my backyard is no more than 800 feet from one of the proposed buildings. There are thirteen homes that line Santa Teresa Blvd, that their backyards face the proposed site. There are 3,000 homes within a mile radius of the site. We just might be able to paint "RESIDENTS LIVES MATTER" on Santa Teresa by the time we fully organize.

My concerns include environmental: noise, traffic, and pollution. Also, if this project is approved, my property value as well as the property value of all my neighbors will be adversely impacted.
