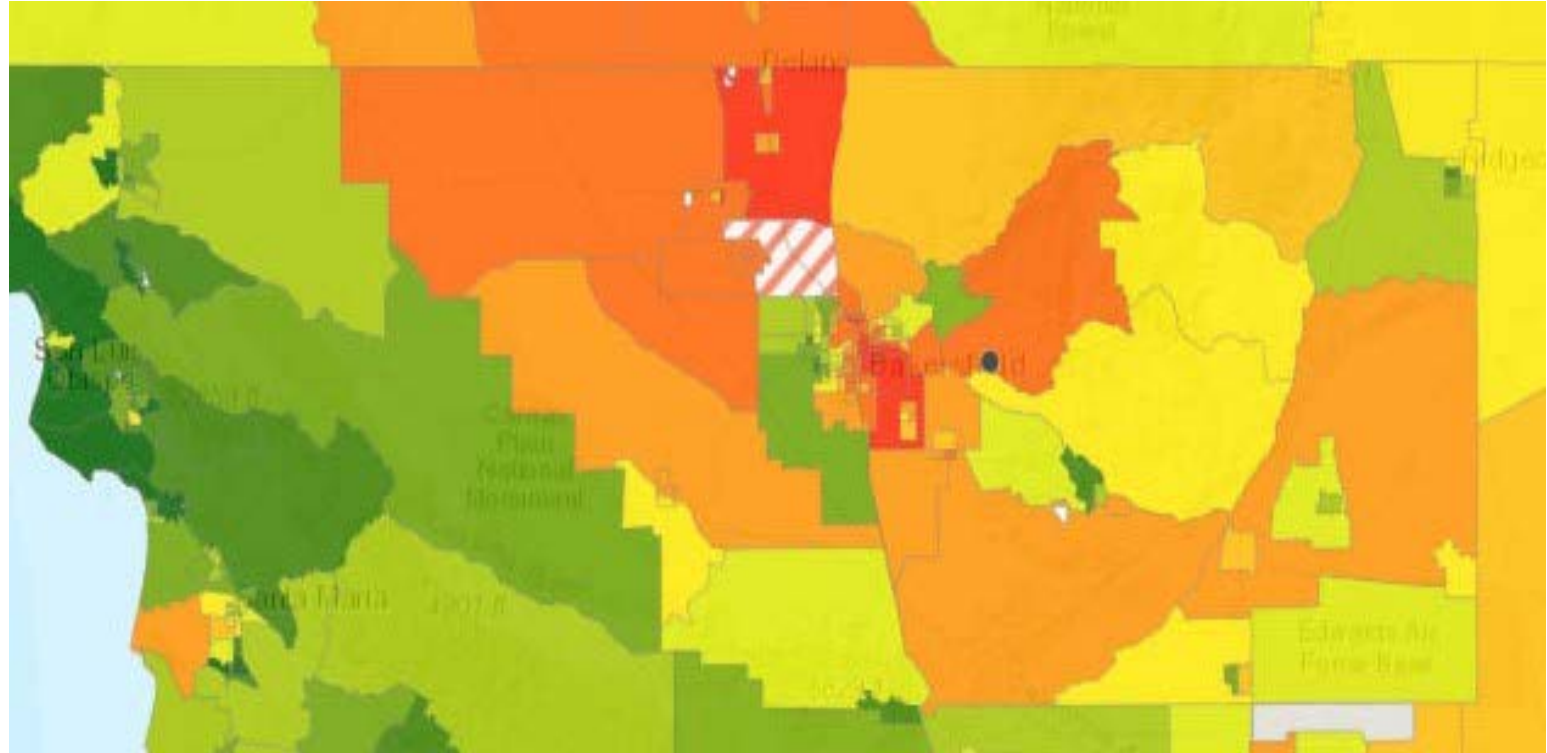
## About Kern COG
