In Chapter 3, Description of the Template-Based Incentive Structure (pg.14); "Using the prescriptive template approach, a program participant would not be required to model their building design specifically for BUILD participation and would simply need to meet basic minimum requirements then likely select..." and in the next paragraph, "This timing is important, as BUILD Program incentives are meant to influence building design decisions." By using the eligible equipment in BUILD, building design will be influenced, and to what degree?
