Lisa, thank you for the follow up.

I have discussed this project with my neighbors and all have expressed concerns about not only the disruption to our lives during the seven year construction phase, but the noise, pollution, and possible explosive nature of the site once fully operational. Additionally, all are concerned that once construction starts on this facility, our property value will be adversely affected.

Another point that I want to make is that in December 2016, residents were not notified of the plans to build a backup diesel powered generating facility. This fact was revealed in a meeting I had with our councilman and the planning commission on 8/14/2020. If we had been notified, we would have had time to organize and voiced our opposition to this project.

In the meeting on 8/14/2020, the planning commission admitted it was a mistake to not notify the residents, but the project as approved in January 2017 would be moving forward.

I'm not sure if there is anything legally that can be done to reverse a wrong, but many of my neighbors have voiced their interest in pursuing legal action.

Thanks again for your follow up and I hope that others listen and understand the neighborhood concerns.
