Hello,

I am writing to ask the commission to implement an all-electric building code for 2022 that requires all new construction to phase out gas connections. All-electric buildings combined with a clean electric grid are the fastest, cheapest way to decarbonize our energy sector.

Governor Newsom recently took strong action with his executive order requiring new vehicles sold in the state to be all-electric by 2035. Now the CEC has the opportunity to take similarly bold action in the building sector.

One major difference is that the technology we need for a fully electric residential sector is already here and can even be cheaper than gas. We just need the leadership to take bold action.
