Pursuant to section 2836 (b)(1) of the California Public Utilities Code, the City of Moreno Valley initiated the process of evaluating the viability of energy storage systems and potentially determine appropriate procurement targets. On September 23, 2014, the City Council approved Resolution 2014-77, declining to establish an energy storage target because the available options of energy storage systems are not cost-effective or do not meet the needs of the utility.

The City continues to evaluate the feasibility of storage systems and should they become cost-effective or fulfill the needs of the utility, they will be procured.
