COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

BACKGROUND

On May 20, 2020, Digital Realty (Applicant) submitted an application for a small power plant exemption (SPPE) for the Lafayette Backup Generating Facility (Application)¹ to the California Energy Commission (CEC).²

On August 25, 2020, the Committee³ (Committee) issued a "Notice of Committee Conference and Related Orders," which among other things directed CEC Staff (Staff) to submit a proposed schedule by August 28, 2020, and directed the Applicant to file a response to Staff's proposal by September 2, 2020. Staff and Applicant met these deadlines.⁵

Staff's August 28, 2020, status report set November 24, 2020, as a reasonable target date for publishing its environmental document.⁶ Applicant's response to Staff's status report supported Staff's target date.⁷
