NOTICE OF REMOTE-ACCESS WORKSHOP

RE: Rulemaking to Modify RPS Enforcement Regulations for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities

Notice of Lead Commissioner Workshop November 5, 2020 1:00 p.m. Remote Access Only

Commissioner Karen Douglas, the California Energy Commission (CEC) Lead Commissioner for Renewable Energy, will host a remote-access workshop to solicit further public and stakeholder comment on proposed modifications to the Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS) enforcement regulations for local publicly owned electric utilities (POUs), hereinafter referred to as the RPS POU Regulations. In light of substantive comments received, the CEC postponed the October 23, 2020, workshop to provide CEC staff, stakeholders, and the public an opportunity to consider those comments.¹

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public is able to participate in the workshop consistent with the direction in these Executive Orders. Instructions for remote participation via Zoom are below.

Agenda

During the workshop, CEC staff will seek additional public and stakeholder input on the proposed modifications to the RPS POU Regulations. While the current rulemaking covers a range of topics, this workshop will focus on key elements of implementing the long-term procurement requirement for POUs. CEC staff will present information on the most recent version of the proposed express terms and additional considerations for possible revisions and clarifications to encourage public and

stakeholder comment. CEC staff will also present information on the process CEC staff proposes to review and verify that contracts meet the criteria to be considered long-term consistent with the RPS POU Regulations.

CEC staff anticipate that the topics for discussion will include, but may not be limited to, contract terms, provisions and structures that may affect the long-term characterization of a contract, including: contract duration, identified procurement quantities, pricing, and early termination clauses, as well as related topics including additional procurement under contracts, replacement energy, and contract amendments and modifications. CEC staff will also provide information and solicit input on proposed processes for POUs to report contract information and submit contract documentation and the processes CEC staff will follow to confirm and verify POU submitted information. The workshop will include time for general public comment.

Background

In May 2020, the CEC instituted a formal rulemaking to consider modifications to existing regulations specifying RPS enforcement rules and procedures for POUs. These regulations are codified in the California Code of Regulations, Title 20, sections 1240 and 3200 – 3208.

On May 7, 2020, the CEC published the Express Terms for the proposed regulations and made them available for a 45-day comment period ending on June 22, 2020. Based on public comment, the CEC decided to propose changes to the Express Terms. These initial changes are referred to as the first 15-day language. On July 21, 2020, the first 15-day language was published and made available for a 15-day comment period ending August 5, 2020. In response to comments received, the CEC proposed a second round of 15-day changes, referred to as the second 15-day language. The CEC published the second 15-day language on August 18, 2020, with a comment period ending on September 2, 2020. On September 8, 2020, in response to comments received, the CEC issued a Notice of Postponement, postponing the September 9, 2020, public adoption hearing of the proposed regulations. On October 9, 2020, the CEC issued a Notice of Postponement, postponing the October 13, 2020, workshop. On October 22, 2020, in response to comments received, the CEC issued a Notice of Postponement, postponement, postponing the October 23, 2020, workshop.

This workshop is an effort to solicit additional public comment on possible revisions and clarifications to the proposed regulations and will be followed by a written public comment period. CEC staff anticipate posting another round of 15-day language with an associated public comment period and ultimately anticipate submitting the proposed regulations to a CEC business meeting to be considered for adoption before the end of the year.
