The California Air Resources Board on November 19, 2020 in Resolution 20-32 requested that the California Energy Commission require all electric appliances and systems in new buildings for the 2022 code cycle. The use of natural gas must be eliminated for California to meet its emission reduction goals. Time is of the essence, and the 2022 code cycle should include a ban on gas pipes to new buildings.
