## **Background**

Assembly Bill 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007), created the Clean Transportation Program. The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change and clean air goals. Assembly Bill 8 (Perea, Chapter 401, Statutes of 2013) reauthorized the funding program through January 1, 2024.

The 2020 – 2023 Investment Plan allocated \$92.7 million for light-duty electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure. The workshop will seek to gather stakeholder feedback on possible EV infrastructure projects which could be funded using funds from the light-duty vehicle allocation. These projects include:

- 1) More access to chargers in rural areas of California.
- 2) Transportation Network Companies (TNC) high power charging to accommodate appbased drivers.
- 3) Programs to support residents who live in multi-unit dwellings such as apartments and condos.
- 4) Further advanced technologies projects such as those proposed with the Built-Environment Electrification Solutions and Form Factors for Fitting Infrastructure to Transportation solicitation.
