On September 16, 2020, Genesis Solar, Inc. filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Heavy Equipment Parking Cover petition to amend. The filing of the petition was completed on December 4, 2020, with the receipt of the filing fee. The 250-megawatt (MW) project was certified by the CEC in September 2010 and began commercial operation (Unit 2) in November 2013. The facility is located at 11995 Wileys Well Road in Blythe, Riverside County, California.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

This request includes the following changes:

The owner, Genesis Solar, LLC, proposes to construct a covered heavy equipment parking structure that will create permanent open-air shade for parking of heavy equipment. The structure would be constructed of steel with concrete foundations. The approximate size of the structure is 200 feet wide, with eight low bays and two high bays. The low bays are 12 high by 12 feet deep; the high bays are 20 feet high and 40 feet deep.
