The California State Pipe Trades Council (CSPTC) is a California Energy Commission (CEC) approved Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider (ATTCP) for non-Residential Mechanical Acceptance Test Technicians and Employers in good standing since August 10, 2016. This letter is to provide the CEC with a status update of the CSPTC ATTCP program.

## **CURRENT ACCEPTANCE TEST EMPLOYERS (ATEs)**

We currently have 90 Mechanical Acceptance Test Employers, with no additional certifications in 2020.

## CURRENT ACCEPTANCE TEST TECHNICIANS

As of this date, we have approximately 105 Mechanical Acceptance Test Technicians and another 71 that are in various stages of fulfilling their requirements to become Mechanical Test Technicians. I have included an up-to-date spreadsheet in this report. 45 ATT's have passed the certification requirements in 2020 and 2021 to date.

As of the date of this letter, there has been no action taken against any ATT or ATE. There is no current mandate, so no activity has taken place over the last year, and no quality assurance or accountability activities have been taken.

The CSPTC continues to meet the requirements of §10-103.2 as an ATTCP.
