This letter is to provide the California Energy Commission with a status update of the NEBB ATTCP program for January 2020 – December 2020.

**TRAINING, CERTIFICATION & REPORTING ACTIVITY:**

To date, NEBB has 1 certified employer and 1 certified technician.

For this reporting period there were no new certifications.

For this reporting period there were no lapsed certifications.

Currently there are 53 ATT applicants in various stages, 38 techs are at the written exam stage (meaning they applied, were vetted/approved to go on to the next step/testing), 1 applicant is at the online courses step (Passed entrance exams – taking online courses.), and several pending certification.

Currently there are 19 Employer applicants who have been vetted and approved to go onto the next steps (online training).

The quality assurance and accountability activities, including the compliance forms review and the onsite audits were not performed as no compliance forms were completed through the registry program during the reporting period.

No projects or acceptance tests have been performed under the NEBB program during this reporting period. This is not to say that no tests have been performed, but none have been done through the Document Registry at this time since there is no mandate in place.

NEBB has had to take no action regarding any administrative actions to correct problems with Mechanical Acceptance Test Technician field performance or ATE's.

The NEBB continues to meet the requirements of §10-103.2 as ATTCP.
