I urge the CEC to set standards in the 2022 Title 24 Building Code that will lead to all-electric new buildings beginning in 2023.

More than 40 cities have adopted local measures to make sure new buildings are all-electric in the future. Abroad, other countries have established new electrification requirements to get gas out of new buildings, including France which will ban gas heating in new homes starting in 2021.

Now it is time for the CEC to step in and take similar action so all Californians are protected.

The CEC is currently writing the 2022 Title 24 Building Code. You must make sure to use this code cycle to stop digging us deeper into the hole of our dependence on dangerous fossil fuels.

A delay will lock us into decades of climate pollution and cost California more than \$1 billion in unnecessary gas infrastructure. Our health and our climate cannot afford this.
