Hi – I was just talking with my project manager and she noted another challenge with this study will be that in most cities, you can't switch from a gas stove to electric without applying for a permit. And you will likely need building inspectors to inspect the work. Just wanted to note that as another possible complication with conducting this study. You will want to make sure the applicants have thought this through.

We did a study with CARB where we installed either stand-alone air cleaners or high-efficiency filters in the HVAC system and looked at air pollution levels and asthma symptoms. For reference, our budget was 3.3 million. We saw changes in indoor levels, but not asthma symptoms. It is very difficult with all the other factors influencing asthma. I know we can't put in an application at 1 million. I would be happy to speak to your team about some of the challenges we had which could be useful for thinking about this project.
