Dear CEC Staff,

Thank you for the opportunity to pose questions regarding the IDEAL ZEV Workforce Pilot:

1. To confirm, can CSUs and their foundations apply as subcontractors?
2. Is a subcontractor limited to one application?
3. Are non-credit certificate programs that are housed at a CSU eligible for tuition reimbursement?
4. Ineligible projects in equity communities include training for OSHA requirements and other required regulatory and compliance training. Please confirm that ineligible projects include required or mandated training, but other training programs that are not required but address project goals (such as regulatory compliance) are allowed.
5. Institutes of Higher Education such as CSUs and community colleges are not eligible to apply as primes. Are Tribal Colleges eligible to submit as prime? Are Tribal Colleges considered Tribal serving non-governmental organizations?

We look forward to learning more about CEC and CARB's expanding workforce development and equity initiatives. Thank you again.
