NOTICE OF RECEIPT

PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION PROJECT CHANGE MAGNOLIA POWER PROJECT (01-AFC-06C)

On February 4, 2021, the Southern California Public Power Authority (SCPPA) filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Magnolia Power Project (MPP). The 323-megawatt combined-cycle facility was certified by the CEC in March 2003, and began commercial operation in September 2005. The facility is located in the City of Burbank, in Los Angeles County.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

This request includes the following change:

- Upgrade the existing MPP combustion system to allow improved combustor turndown and increased operating flexibility to integrate better with intermittent renewable energy resources.

The review process includes an evaluation of the effect the change could have on the environment; the project's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards; and whether a change to, addition of, or deletion of any condition of certification is required.

After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this petition, staff will publish an assessment for public review and comment. Staff will also provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposed changes as a staff approved project change or schedule the project change to be heard for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.
