PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION PROJECT CHANGE EL SEGUNDO ENERGY CENTER (00-AFC-14C)

On March 16, 2021, El Segundo Energy Center, LLC, filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the El Segundo Energy Center (ESEC). The 560-megawatt (MW), natural gas-fired, combined-cycle electric generating facility was certified by the CEC on February 5, 2005, and began operation on August 1, 2013. The facility is located at 301 Vista Del Mar Blvd., El Segundo.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

The petition requests to uprate the gas turbine Units 5 and 7. The fuel input on an hourly basis would increase, resulting in an increase in output of the respective gas turbines. The maximum output of the facility would increase from 573.4 megawatts (MW) to 580.4 MW, while the net output would increase to 560 MW. This request includes the following changes in the license:

- Change the input heat rate and the output power of the Combined Cycle Gas
 Turbines (CCGTs) in the Equipment Description from 2,096 million British thermal
 units (MMBtu) per hour to 2,250 MMBtu per hour, and the electrical output from 219
 MW to 222.5 MW for each of the two CCGTs; and
- Modify air quality Condition of Certification AQ-11 to allow for higher monthly VOC emissions and to include a fuel use limit of 51,162 MMBtu per day.

This notice of receipt is being mailed to the CEC's facilities mail list of interested parties and property owners of parcels within 1000 feet of the facility site. The petition requesting the project change has been docketed and is available on the CEC's webpage for this facility at: https://www2.energy.ca.gov/sitingcases/elsegundo/

REVIEW PROCESS

This petition is reviewed pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations section 1769. The review process includes an evaluation of the effect the change could have on the environment; the project's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards; and whether a change to, addition of, or deletion of any condition of certification is required.

Because the petition seeks to increase emission limits set in a condition of certification adopted by the CEC, it does not meet the criteria for staff approval under Section 1769(a)(3). After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this

petition, staff will publish an assessment for public review and comment. Thereafter, staff will then schedule the project change to be heard for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.
