The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop to present the draft Building Decarbonization Assessment required by Assembly Bill 3232 (Friedman, Chapter 373, Statutes of 2018) (AB 3232). A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the direction in these Executive Orders. There will be opportunities for public comment. Instructions for remote participation via Zoom are below.

**Agenda**

Staff presentations include an overview of the draft Building Decarbonization Assessment report and the building decarbonization scenarios developed by staff to assess the feasibility and costs of various building decarbonization strategies. Time will be allotted for public comments. Written comments with supporting documents or data are encouraged (see below for submittal instructions).

A detailed meeting schedule and the draft assessment will be posted on the Building Decarbonization Assessment webpage, <https://www.energy.ca.gov/data-reports/reports/building-decarbonization-assessment>, and the Decarbonization docket, 19-DECARB-01, prior to the workshop.

**Background**

AB 3232 requires the CEC to assess the technical feasibility of reducing greenhouse gas emissions from residential and commercial buildings 40 percent below 1990 levels by 2030, in consultation

with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), California Air Resources Board (CARB), and the California Independent System Operator. On December 4, 2019, the CEC held the “Building Decarbonization Assessment – Project Scope” public workshop. On February 27, 2020, staff presented the Fuel Substitution Scenario Analysis Tool (FSSAT) that has been instrumental to conducting the assessment. On May 22, 2020, staff held the “Building Decarbonization: Opportunities and Challenges of the Commercial and Residential Building Sectors” public workshop.
