Jack,

The answers to the air questions were provided with the filing on 1/2. When Keith last saw these I believe he was OK with all of the responses except the one dealing with mitigation for San Joaquin Valley. As we stated in the data adequacy sheets, we have supplied SJVAPCD with the AFC, modeling protocols, and other project information. Even though we believe that the Tesla AFC has addressed all LORS associated with Air Quality, we recognize that the unique position of the plant may require additional scrutiny by the CEC and SJVAPCD during the discovery phase of the licensing process. In order to expedite this review and move the project into data adequacy, we have had several conversations with Seyed Sadredin (Director of Permit Services, SJVAPCD) this week discussing ways to analyze possible impacts and assess mitigation. Based on our discussions to date we believe that a specific format can be agreed upon in the next few weeks and a variety of possible mitigation plans will be identified.

Seyed (559-230-5900) is anticipating a call from CEC staff to confirm the ongoing discussions, but will be out of the office on Monday and Tuesday of next week.
