# Notice of Workshop to Present Next Steps for Considering Offshore Wind Energy off the California Coast June 21, 2021

# 2:00 p.m. Remote Access Only

The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to present the next steps to consider offshore wind energy in federal waters off the California coast. A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public is able to participate in the workshop consistent with the direction in these executive orders. There will be opportunities for public comment. Instructions for remote participation via Zoom are below.

# Agenda

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) and state agencies will present the next steps in the process for leasing areas for offshore wind energy off the California coast, including tribal engagement, the public process, public comment opportunities, and planned public and stakeholder outreach. As described below, there will be an opportunity for public comment during the workshop following the presentation.

# Background

The first meeting of the BOEM California Intergovernmental Renewable Energy Task Force (California Task Force) was held in October 2016, and the second meeting in September 2018. In October 2018, BOEM published a Call for Information and Nominations (Call) for three areas off the California coast: Diablo Canyon Call Area, Morro Bay Call Area, and Humboldt Call Area.



On May 25, 2021, the Department of the Interior, in cooperation with the Department of Defense and the State of California, identified an area ("the Morro Bay 399 Area") that is roughly 399 square miles off California's central coast region, northwest of Morro Bay that encompasses much of the existing Morro Bay Call Area, as a potential area for offshore wind energy. The Department of the Interior is also advancing the Humboldt Call Area as a potential Wind Energy Area (WEA), located off California's north coast.

BOEM, in partnership with the State of California, announced that they would hold a California Task Force meeting on June 24, 2021 to discuss the identified areas off the north and central coasts and next steps in the BOEM leasing process. In light of unforeseen scheduling conflicts with the Pacific Fishery Management Council meeting, BOEM and the State of California have rescheduled the California Task Force meeting to July 13, 2021.

In order to share information, the CEC, in partnership with BOEM will host a public workshop to present the next steps in BOEM's process to identify areas off the north and central coasts as potential WEAs ahead of the July 13, 2021 California Task Force meeting.
