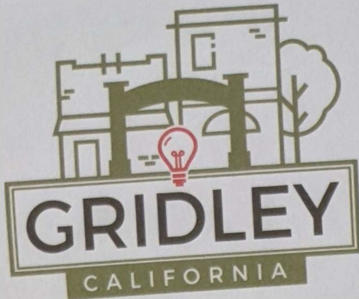

Greetings Mr. Mathias,


I hope this letter finds you doing well!

Pursuant to section 2836 (b)(1) of the California Public Utilities Code, the City of Gridley (Gridley) City Council determined in October of 2014 that commercially available energy storage systems were not currently viable and cost effective at that time, and did not adopt any energy storage targets. Gridley committed to reevaluate energy storage systems not less than every three years as required by AB 2514. Gridley still does not find energy storage as a viable or cost-effective technology to invest in at this time.

Gridley will continue to assess the feasibility of evaluate energy storage projects and technologies, and will consider procurement opportunities should they become cost-effective.
