Notice to Consider Adoption of Draft Commission Guidelines for the California Schools Healthy Air, Plumbing, and Efficiency Ventilation Program

As part of the California Energy Commission's (CEC) June 25, 2021 business meeting, the CEC will consider adoption of the Draft Commission Guidelines for the California Schools Healthy Air, Plumbing, and Efficiency (CalSHAPE) Ventilation Program.

The business meeting will be held remotely, consistent with Executive Order N-08-21 and the recommendations from the California Department of Public Health to encourage physical distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19. The public can participate in the business meeting consistent with the direction in these executive orders. There will be opportunities for public comment. Instructions for remote participation and a detailed agenda will be posted prior to the CEC's Business Meeting. Background

The School Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program was enacted by Assembly Bill (AB) 841 (Ting, Chapter 372, Statutes of 2020) and includes two grant programs: the School Reopening Ventilation and Energy Efficiency Verification and Repair Program (CalSHAPE Ventilation Program), and the School Noncompliant Plumbing Fixture and Appliance Program (CalSHAPE Plumbing Program).

The CalSHAPE Ventilation Program provides funding to California schools to assess, maintain, and repair ventilation systems, prioritizing schools in underserved communities as defined by AB 841. The CalSHAPE Plumbing Program provides funding to California schools and state agencies to replace aging and inefficient plumbing fixtures and appliances with water-conserving plumbing fixtures and appliances, also prioritizing schools in underserved communities as defined by AB 841.

The *CalSHAPE Plumbing Program Guidelines* were considered and adopted at the June 9, 2021, business meeting. The adoption of the *CalSHAPE Ventilation Program Guidelines* was postponed to provide time for CEC staff to consider a proposal to increase the program’s maximum award amounts.

CEC staff evaluated data provided by stakeholders and have updated the maximum award amounts in the *CalSHAPE Ventilation Program Draft Commission Guidelines (Updated on June 18, 2021)*. The changes to the maximum award amounts are shown in the following table:

CalSHAPE Ventilation Program Guidelines Maximum Award Revisions

Eligible Items	Previous Maximum Award Amount	Revised Maximum Award Amount
HVAC Assessment and Maintenance and HVAC Assessment Report	\$40,000	\$10,000 plus \$1,000 per HVAC unit
Carbon Dioxide Monitors	\$500 per monitor	\$600 per monitor
Filters	\$75 per filter	No change
Assessment and HVAC Assessment Report for Limited or No Mechanical Ventilation Pathway	\$4,000	No change
HVAC Assessment Report for Scheduled for Replacement Pathway	\$2,000	No change

The updates to the guidelines are on pages 26 – 28 and are shown in bold underline/strikethrough format with proposed language appearing in bold underline and proposed deletions appearing in strikethrough.
