2021 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR): Request for Extension of Time to File Certain Electricity Demand Forecasts

Dear Licha Lopez:

This letter is in response to your June 3, 2021, request to extend the filing deadline for Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) to submit Electricity Demand Forecast forms required by the California Energy Commission (CEC) in support of the 2021 Integrated Energy Policy Report (2021 IEPR). The CEC adopted detailed instructions describing the scope and timing of required data submissions at a business meeting on May 12, 2021.

PG&E seeks an extension from June 30, 2021 to July 30, 2021 to submit all components of Electricity Demand Forecast forms 1, 2, 3, and 4. The extension would accommodate PG&E's intention to revise its forecast in response to a recent proposed decision published by the CPUC.

Noting that form 8 builds on information provided in form 1, PG&E seeks an extension from June 30, 2021 to August 31, 2021, to submit Electricity Demand forms 8.1a and 8.1b.

I appreciate that PG&E wants to submit data of the highest quality and find that good cause exists for the extensions.

In accordance with Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1342(c), I grant the request for extending the deadlines to submit Electricity Demand Forecast forms 1.1a through 4 and the Electricity Demand forms 8.1a, and 8.1b.
