STATEMENT OF STAFF APPROVAL PETITION FOR CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP for the PROCTER AND GAMBLE COGENERATION PROJECT (93-AFC-02C)

On July 15, 2021, a petition was filed and docketed with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to change ownership of Procter and Gamble Cogeneration Project from the Sacramento Cogeneration Authority to the Sacramento Municipal Utility District Financing Authority (SFA). The petition also notes that the name of the project, "Procter and Gamble Cogeneration Project," will change to "Procter and Gamble Power Plant." The 184-megawatt cogeneration facility was certified by the CEC on November 16, 1994 and began operation on March 1, 1997. The facility is located in Sacramento County at 5000 83rd Street.

The petition is requesting to change ownership of the facility to SFA. A statement describing the change in ownership, signed under penalty of perjury by a representative of SFA, was submitted as required by Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). The statement affirms that SFA understands the conditions of certification and agrees to comply with those conditions.

Staff has reviewed the petition and has determined that the petition meets the requirements of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). Accordingly, staff hereby approves the petition to change ownership. Any person may file an objection to staff's approval within 14 days of the filing of this notice. Any such objection must state the grounds for the objection. If a person files such an objection, the petition will be considered by the CEC at a noticed business meeting or hearing.

An objection to staff's approval may be submitted using the CEC's e-Commenting feature. Go to the CEC's <u>Procter and Gamble Cogeneration Project webpage</u>, click on the "<u>Submit e-Comment</u>" link, and follow the instructions in the on-line form. Be sure to include the facility name in your comments.
