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Including Grid Efficiency in the CEC EPIC Considerations

Having participated in a few workshops on EPIC and navigated the CEC website, I feel some really good work is being done to transition us to a carbon neutral future. However, much focus is being placed on efficiency of generation and on efficiency/management of consumption, but no focus is being placed on grid efficiency.
