**DOCUMENT HANDLING FOR THE TESLA POWER PROJECT (01- AFC-21)

At the January 9, 2002 business meeting, the California Energy Commission determined the Tesla Power Project Application for Certification (AFC) and supplemental material to be data adequate, thus beginning the discovery, and analysis phases of the energy facility siting process.

Please make this AFC supplemental material available for those who may wish to be informed about the project by including it with the previously supplied AFC. We request that you not allow the AFC or any of its contents to be removed from the library. To increase accessibility of the document we ask, if possible, that you cross reference it as a general reference work under the title and author categories, as well as under such subjects as "Energy Commission," "electricity energy/generation," "power plant siting," or any other relevant subject.

The Energy Commission's siting process is open to the public and incorporates the input of the public as well as local, state and federal agencies. To facilitate public participation in our review process, the Energy Commission distributes copies of any AFC and supplemental material to libraries in Los Angeles, San Francisco, San Diego, Fresno and Eureka, as well as to public libraries in communities near the proposed project.
