Assembly Bill 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007) created the CTP. The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change and clean air goals. Assembly Bill 8 (Perea, Chapter 401, Statutes of 2013) reauthorized the funding program through January 1, 2024.
