The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop on the draft 2022 Energy Code Residential and Nonresidential Compliance Manuals and associated compliance documents (i.e., "forms"). The Compliance Manuals serve as reference guides intended to aid professionals with compliance and enforcement of the recently adopted 2022 Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Energy Code). The forms are used to demonstrate compliance with the 2022 Energy Code to building departments or other enforcement agencies. All interested parties, agencies, and members of the public are welcome to participate and comment.

The workshop will be held remotely consistent with Assembly Bill 361 (Rivas, Chapter 165, Statutes of 2021) to improve and enhance public access to state agency meetings during the COVID-19 pandemic by allowing broader access through teleconferencing options. The public can participate in the meeting consistent with the direction provided below. Please note that the CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the agenda proposed. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time depending on various factors.

**Agenda**

The CEC will present draft revisions to the supporting 2022 Energy Code resources and solicit public comments ahead of CEC approval. Interested parties will have the opportunity to comment on the draft 2022 Energy Code Compliance Manuals and summary of compliance documents for Title 24, Parts 1 and 6.

## **Background**

The CEC approves compliance manuals for each update to the Energy Code. The public is invited to submit comments to the docket on the draft manuals no later than January 7, 2022. The manuals are written as instructional guides and can be helpful for anyone that is directly or indirectly involved in the design and construction of energy efficient nonresidential and residential buildings. The 2022 Energy Code Compliance Manuals provide guidance concerning the 2022 Energy Code requirements to help building department plans examiners and inspectors, and building owners, designers, builders, and energy consultants to comply with and enforce the 2022 Energy Code.
