The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop to present and gather stakeholder feedback on the Zero-Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Infrastructure Plan (ZIP). A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The workshop will be held remotely, consistent with Assembly Bill 361 (Rivas, Chapter 165, Statutes of 2021) to improve and enhance public access to state agency meetings during the COVID-19 pandemic. Background

On September 23, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Executive Order N-79-20, setting a 100 percent ZEV target for new passenger vehicle sales by 2035 and 100 percent ZEV operations target for medium-and heavy-duty vehicles in the state by 2045. The California Air Resources Board is developing Advanced Clean Cars II and Advanced Clean Fleets regulations to help the state achieve its climate and air quality goals. Similarly, many state agencies are coordinating efforts to support the transition to a zero-emission vehicle future for all Californians. The ZIP will support the ZEV Market Development Strategy developed by The Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development (GO-Biz) in collaboration with multiple state agencies, addressing the "infrastructure" pillar of that strategy.

This workshop will seek early input to the ZIP which will further describe the state's pathway to deploying the ZEV infrastructure necessary to support the level of ZEV adoption needed to meet state goals. An outline of the ZIP will be published on the event page before the workshop.
