Senate Bill 129 (Skinner, Budget Act of 2021) authorized \$20 million from the General Fund to the CEC to support a grant program for cities, counties, or cities and counties to establish online solar permitting. Funds are available for encumbrance until June 30, 2023, and available for liquidation until June 30, 2027.
