Re: CalCERTS, Inc.'s Request for Clarification on EDDS Applications

CalCERTS is requesting clarification from the California Energy Commission (Commission) in response to the Staff Reports recommending approval for the two EDDS Applications submitted to the Docket 19-HERS-01 by ConSol Home Energy Efficiency Rating Services (CHEERS).

In the applications and Staff Reports specific to the application, the Commission evaluated the connections between Authorized Users, EDD Diagnostic Tools or Software, and the HERS Registry. (See Staff Workshop Presentation Docket # 241112). In each application both the users and tools are specifically identified. Docket # 240954 identifies Energy and the BOSS EDDS system, and Docket # 240955 identifies Archon Energy Solutions and the Compass EDDS.

CalCERTS has the following requests for clarification in response to the process and Staff Reports:

- 1) Are all Authorized Users of the EDDS Diagnostic Tools or Software required to be disclosed in the EDDS Applications for Commission approval?
- 2) If approved EDD Diagnostic Tools or Software are made available to new categories of Authorized Users, such as alternate Rating Firms, Installers, Builder, will the Commission post amended notices to the Docket?
- 3) Are amendments to the scope of Authorized Users for the EDD Diagnostic Tools or Software considered significant changes by the Commission with respect to the approval process?

CalCERTS appreciates the opportunity to seek clarification from the Commission on the EDDS application process. We understand this is a collaborative effort to help bring new tools and innovation to the HERS Program.

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
