Notice of Availability for Access Energy Code Compliance Document XML Schema Package

The California Energy Commission (CEC) is making the current versions of the 2022 Energy Code Extensible Markup Language (XML) Schema Package available to the public. XML Schema is a markup language and file format for storing, transmitting, and reconstructing data. XML Schema is a description for a specific type of XML document, typically expressed as specifications regarding the structure and content of an electronic document. The CEC uses XML Schema files to validate compliance documents (which are published as XML documents) required by the California Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Energy Code) for newly constructed and existing buildings.

The CEC is making available the draft XML Schema Package for the 2022 Energy Code nonresidential compliance documents. These drafts include the XML Schema, data dictionary, pseudo code, Data Registry Requirements Manual, and other materials necessary to obtain approval for and operate a data registry under Title 24, Part 6. The XML Schema Package is a series of electronic-only documents and is not available as a printed publication.
