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## NOTICE OF RECEIPT PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION CHANGE Mountainview Generating Station (00-AFC-02C)

On February 16, 2022, Southern California Edison (SCE), project owner, filed a petition for a post-certification change (TN#241555) with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Mountainview Generating Station (MVGS).

The 1,056-megawatt project was certified by the CEC on March 21, 2001, and began commercial operation on January 19, 2006. The facility is located on a 54.3-acre parcel in the city of Redlands, in San Bernardino County.

## SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

The project owner seeks approval to modify the facility by installing an electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure for eight fleet and six employee vehicle charging stations. EV charging infrastructure will be installed at the existing parking lot with no undeveloped areas or additional areas being disturbed.

## **REVIEW PROCESS**

This petition is reviewed pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769. The review process includes an evaluation of the effect the change could have on the environment; the project's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards; and whether a change to, or deletion of any condition of certification adopted by the CEC in the final decision or subsequent amendments is required.

After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this petition, the assessment will be published for public review and comment. Included in the staff analysis, staff will provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposed changes as a staff-approved project change or schedule it for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.

## **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

This notice of receipt is being mailed to the CEC's MVGS mailing list of interested agencies, the public, and property owners that requested placement on the mailing list as well as to property owners within 1,000 feet of the facility site and 500 feet of the facility linear features (for example, pipeline).
