**I. INTRODUCTION**

The applicant filed a motion (TN 242468) on March 25, 2022, requesting that the Committee assigned to the San Jose City Data Center Small Power Plant Exemption proceeding adjust the Revised Scheduling Order (TN 242335) for the proposed San Jose Data Center project issued by California Energy Commission (CEC) Chair David Hochschild on March 15, 2022. Specifically, the applicant requests that the dates for filing Opening Testimony (April 14, 2022) and Reply Testimony (April 28, 2022) be adjusted to April 1, 2022, and April 8, 2022, respectively.

**II. STAFF RESPONSE**

The CEC staff has no objection to the applicant's motion. Staff filed a minor Addendum to the Final Environmental Impact Report Part 1 (TN 242489) and the San Jose Data Center Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (TN 242492) (agreed to by the City of San Jose) on March 29, 2022. Staff will file its Opening Testimony, to comprise previously docketed materials, along with declarations and resumes, by whichever date the Committee directs the parties to do so.
