California Energy Commission (CEC) staff will host a pre-application workshop for GFO-21-605 Zero-Emission Transportation Manufacturing (ZETM) funding solicitation. The funding solicitation will provide grant funding for in-state manufacturing of zero-emission vehicles (ZEV), ZEV components, including electric vehicle batteries, and ZEV charging and fueling infrastructure. The workshop will be held remotely. The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the instructions below and will have opportunities for public comment. No CEC commissioners are expected to attend.

Background

CEC staff has developed a competitive grant funding opportunity that will provide up to \$60 million of General Fund monies authorized by the Budget Act of 2021. The Budget Act of 2021 includes \$3.9 billion to support the transition to zero-emission vehicles, support in-state manufacturing, and create jobs. The funding is over three fiscal years (FY) and includes \$1.165 billion to be administered by the CEC.¹ FY 2021-2022 includes \$125 million to increase in-state manufacturing of ZEVs, ZEV components and batteries, and ZEV charging or refueling equipment.² An additional \$125 million is anticipated for FY 2022-2023, pending appropriation in that year's budget. As described in the Budget Act of 2021, the CEC's selection criteria for manufacturing grants should include the following:

- Likelihood that manufacturing activities would not have otherwise occurred in-state either in terms of the entity's presence in California or at the scale that may not otherwise be achieved without the manufacturing grant.
- Number and quality of direct and indirect jobs created.
- Economic impact to the state.
- Ability of the project to contribute to California's goals of zero-emission transportation.

The CEC intends to administer these one-time manufacturing funds under the Clean Transportation Program. Established in 2007 by Assembly Bill 118 (Nunez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007), the CEC's Clean Transportation Program provides funds for projects to develop and deploy innovative technologies that transform California's fuel and vehicle types to help attain the state's climate change policies. The Clean Transportation Program has previously issued funding solicitations related to ZEVs, ZEV components, and ZEV infrastructure manufacturing.
